Consisting of a series of chambers formed over millions of years, Dunmore Cave contains some of the finest calcite formations found in any Irish cave. The cave is first mentioned in the 9th century Irish Triads, but its most interesting reference comes from the Annals which tells of a Viking massacre at the cave in the year 928 A.D.
